


Center Panel Quilts

- * these quilts start with a center panel that is a multiple of 5" plus $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. (e.g. $10\frac{1}{2}$ ", $15\frac{1}{2}$ ", $20\frac{1}{2}$ ", etc.)
- * an inner border is added to each side. It is cut 3" x w.o.f.
- * $5\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ cut squares are added next. They can be "solids", rail fence squares, "I Spy" squares - whatever looks good!
- * A final border is added around the quilt. This border can be whatever width you want to get the quilt size you wish. Many of the quilts are 40" at this point, so add the sides first, then top + bottom borders. That way you will have long enough strips.
- * In most kits we have added extra fabric so you have some design choices. But always count and check before you begin to sew!!




Quilt 35" x 45"

center panel
cut $15\frac{1}{2}'' \times 20\frac{1}{2}''$

inner borders
cut 3" x w.o.f.

squares cut $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$
need 22

outer border
3" or
whatever!



Quilt 40 x 50

center panel
cut $20\frac{1}{2}'' \times 30\frac{1}{2}''$

inner borders
cut 3" x w.o.f.

squares cut $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$
need 28

outer border
cut 3"
