Friday, March 22, 2019, 9-4 Under the Apple Tree – Pictorial Machine Applique

This easy pattern is uniquely designed to teach my turned-edge, layered, machine-appliqué technique using freezer paper templates, liquid starch and nylon invisible thread.

Required kit fee (\$30): *includes pattern, freezer paper, pre-washed fabrics, machine needle and YLI invisible thread* This class is best-suited for today's domestic sewing machines. Older domestic machine models, basic straight stitch models and/or portable sewing machines are not well-suited for this class.

Supplies needed:

A sewing machine with 'adjustable blind hem stitch' capability – bring your manual. Sewing machine extension table

Open toe or zigzag foot

Bobbin wound with white or ecru thread

Paper-cutting scissors

Fabric-cutting scissors

Hand sewing needle: he recommends Bohin #11 applique needle

Hand sewing thread: he uses Superior Masterpiece cotton (50/2)

Small straight pins for applique

Pencil

Resealable plastic bag to hold cut-out applique shapes

Trolley needle (finger stiletto) optional but very useful

Tweezers

Thread snips
