

On October 20, 2009, the membership was read the following proposed change to the by-laws of the organization:

"The By Laws of QUILTERS CONNECTION may be amended by a 2/3 vote of members present and voting at a meeting, provided that the proposed amendment has been read at a previous meeting or provided that members have been otherwise notified."

What the Executive Board wants to do is change Article II, paragraph B, of the By Laws

FROM:

The eight voting members of the executive Board shall consist of the elected Officers: the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and the appointed Chairs of the Program, Newsletter, Membership and Quilt Show Committees.

TO:

B. The eight voting members of the executive Board shall consist of the elected Officers: the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, the appointed Chairs of the Program, Membership and Quilt Show Committees and an appointed Member at Large."

Jessica can announce this at the September meeting, the proposed amendment can be printed in the October Quiltations and a vote can be taken at the October meeting; if a majority approves, the change is effected.

On November 23, 2009, the proposed change was read again, Irene Dwyer moved to accept the proposed change, Ann Bonsett seconded, and a majority of the member voted in favor.
