

3D EPP - A Workshop with Julia McLeod

Class Description and Supply List.

3D EPP? Yes! Three Dimensional English Paper Piecing!

In this hand sewing class we will create three dimensional patchwork objects.

Make holiday decorations, baby toys, or just *pleasingly intriguing things!*

Explore fussy cutting opportunities to create beautiful kaleidoscopic effects.

Embellish with buttons and beads



All these objects were made from just three different patches

Supplies:

- At minimum, two or three fat quarters of fabric, contrasting in color. You can also bring more fabric choices, especially if you want to get into fussy cutting motifs from a patterned fabric
- Medium weight sewing needle. Bring a selection from your sewing box. Everyone has their favorite. My preference is for Bohin #9 long appliqué needles. I will also have some curved needles for you to try. Please don't shop unnecessarily
- Regular sewing thread in a color that matches your fabrics
- Scissors
- Decorative buttons, beads, ribbon and tassels if you like to add embellishment. These can also be added after class, once the object is completed

Optional aids could include -

- Needle threader, reader glasses, light

I will supply pre-cut triangles, squares and diamonds. You will choose your project and take what you need.

If our class is on Zoom, you will need to cut your own triangles, squares and diamonds from Pelon's 71F Peltex, or from cardboard.
