

Quilters' Connection Winter Workshop

Winter Workshop takes place on a Saturday when the guild members get together to share their talents, learn from each other, and enjoy a potluck lunch. The date is set by the QC Board and varies between January and March.

A dozen member volunteer or are drafted to teach some skill or project they want to share, over a period of 3 hours. Past classes have included hand applique, mounting your work on stretcher frames, purses, snapped wallets, extremely narrow strip insertions, and rubber stamping on fabric. At a QC meeting, members sign up for their preferred classes and for the category of potluck food they will bring for the lunch.

Non-members may have the option of signing up for any classes that have open space after the member sign-up period is over. They pay a fee of \$10 to participate. Local guilds in the area may be notified of non-member signup opportunities, or the QC website will indicate which classes are full in the weeks before Winter Workshop. Members attend for free (unless future meeting space is too expensive for the guild to underwrite).
